Not a swimmer but without a peer as a fisher. Does not have a nest. Eggs are laid in a burrow from 3 to 15 feet long. Ranges over most of North America. Feeds mostly on fish and larger water insects. Does more good than harm unless it moves close to a fish hatchery.
